I think of multiple couples, who attend together and have served in many ways along with being regular smiling faces in the crowd. I wish I could give you more details, but the important thing is God has added to our team numerous humble servants (of course there is always room for you).

I thank God that I had the opportunity to drive a man around who I've known for 21 years. I met him first when I ran his cell hall as a corrections officer in the year 2000. I met him again when I started doing prison ministry on the Hill (Sioux Falls) in 2010. I met him again after he got transferred to the Mike Durfee State Prison where we had planted Living Stone around 2016. I met him again when he was released early this year and attended Freedom's Gate Church. It's difficult to find housing when you are a felon, so I agreed to drive him around one morning to look at options when it hit me, I used to lock this guy up and now I'm helping him embrace freedom spiritually and physically. Oh, the joy in serving Jesus!!

Well, I have not run out of things to be thankful for, but I have run out of room. But before I close, I would like to thank God for you! So many of you have journeyed with us through the years and have become friends. We would welcome you to attend Living Stone and or Freedom's Gate for yourself as both are open to guests again (FG always was LS just recently was cleared to have guests again).
