Growing up, I had gone to many churches and met many different people, but just because people go to church doesn't mean they will welcome you. I felt welcomed at Living Stone Church. The pastor's name was Jason Wiersma. and it was his calm demeanor and warm welcome that made me feel relaxed. There were a few bad apples in the crowd, but there were many good ones that made for a friendly atmosphere. I didn't feel threatened when I was at Living Stone Church.

I can't remember the first message or church service that I went to, but I can remember the first moment that Jason made an impact on my life. I can remember sitting on the far right-hand side of the podium in the visit room, when Jason read from the book, 'You are Special' by Max Lucado. At first, I thought it was silly reading a children's book in a room full of societies rejects. The more I listened to the words the more I could relate. As he finished the book, I found it hard to hold back the tears welling up inside of me. When I got back to the barracks, count was finished, and lights were out, I wept silently into my pillow. If God made me and He thinks I'm special, then maybe I am.

I've heard and read the stories in the Bible, but nothing has impacted me so much. Maybe I wasn't listening. It took a children's book to wake me up to keep going to church. I kept going to Living Stone and am happy to be a part of Freedom's Gate Church now on the outside. Again, it provides a safe, secure, and a non-judgmental church to go where I feel welcome.

Jason and Ruth Wiersma have done a great deal for men and women, in and out of prison. They are great people who believe in helping others out who need it. I feel thankful to be able to help out in our services. I'm grateful for all the people who help the church with donations and food. It allows the church to help others hear God's message in a safe place.

I know I'm not perfect and I'm still trying every day, to be a little bit better than yesterday. Some days

go to Freedom's Gate, I can be myself there. I know being a part of Freedom's Gate Church, makes me feel special.
