
FREEDOM'S GATE CHURCH

In the year 2020 during the pandemic, Freedom's Gate Church was planted by Pastor Jason and Ruth Wiersma in Sioux Falls. South Dakota under God's direction. A group of South Dakota inmates originally put together a proposal for a new church plant in Sioux Falls that would cater to the spiritual needs of those coming out of the prison system. The cry of the inmates leading the charge was a response to the past failures of released men and women who failed to acclimate well to society and struggled to find a place of worship that they felt comfortable with or that they could serve in. We started out worshiping in a garage and have since moved 2 times to allow for growth..
